- ▶ DFW has non-stop flights to 137 domestic and 35 international destinations.
- ▶ Nearly 9 percent of all U.S. connecting passengers use DFW.
- ▶ DFW's local market revenue pool is more than \$6 billion, the tenth largest market in the United States.
- ▶ In terms of operations, DFW is the 3rd busiest airport in the world.
- ▶ At \$11 billion, DFW ranks seventh among all U.S. airports in total local & connect revenue generation.

- ▶ DFW has a 16.6 billion dollar economic impact on the region, creating over 300,000 jobs.
- ▶ Opened in 1989, Alliance Airport was the world's first purely industrial airport. The airport is now home to over 200 companies and serves as a cargo hub for Fed Ex.
- ▶ Alliance Airport is responsible for the creation of 99,520 direct and indirect jobs in the region, having an annual economic impact of \$2.52 billion.
- ▶ Alliance Airport received an Award of Excellence, Business Park Large Scale, by the Urban Land Institute.
