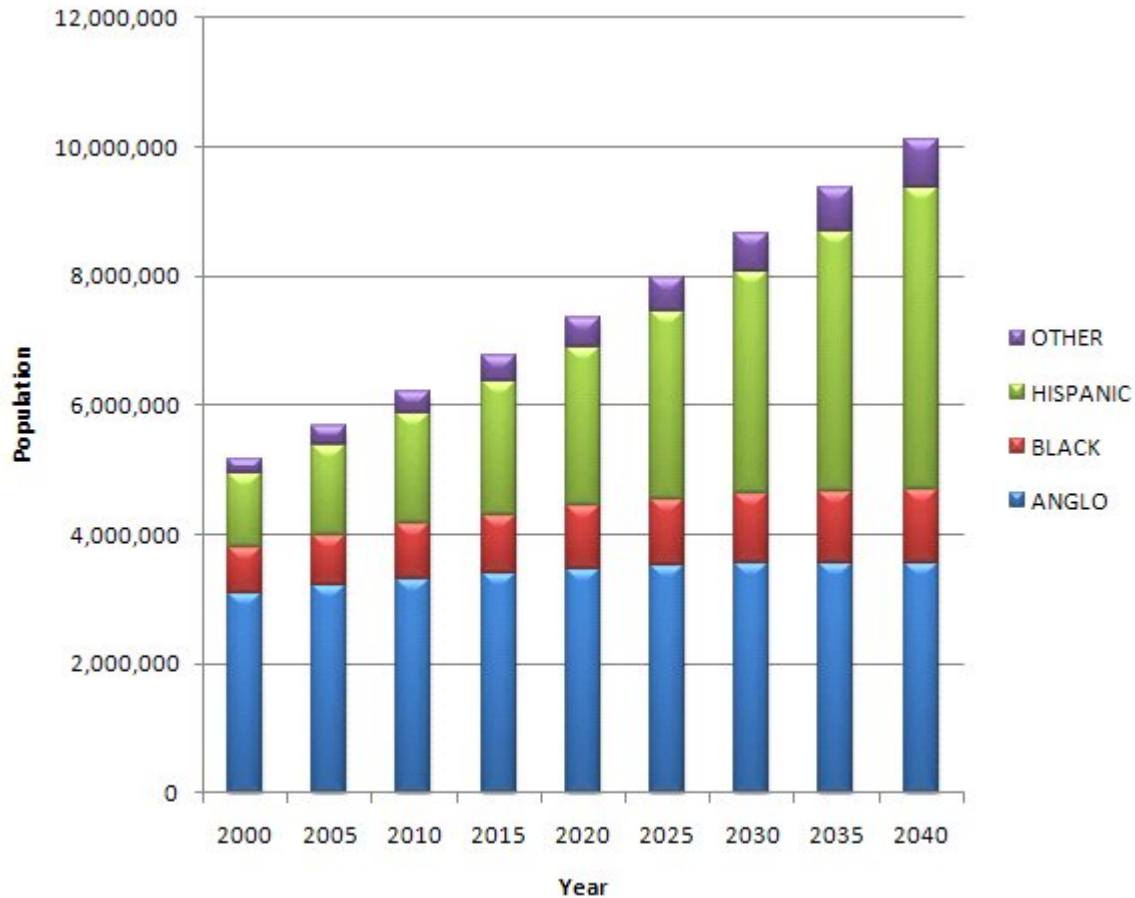


Dallas-Fort Worth Population Projections

- ▶ If the Dallas-Fort Worth region were a state it would rank 17th in population, its 6.4 million residents would place it ahead of Tennessee and Missouri. (U.S. Census Bureau, 2009)
- ▶ Dallas-Fort Worth has a population exceeding that of North and South Dakota, Alaska, Delaware, Vermont, Wyoming, and the District of Columbia combined. (US Census Bureau, 2009)
- ▶ From 2007-2008 the region added 400 new residents a day. (U.S. Census Bureau, 2009)
- ▶ From 2010 to 2040 the region is projected to grow by 3,900,000 or 63%. (Texas State Data Center)
