- ▶ The total health industry for North Texas is greater than the health industry of 31 other states. (*Bureau of Labor Statistics, Current Employment Statistics*)
- ▶ The DFW area is home to over 100 hospitals, with more than 17,000 beds, and nearly 12,800 physicians, practicing a total of 175 specialties. (*Texas Department of State Health Services, Texas Medical Board*)
- ▶ The Dallas region is an international medical center for burns and trauma care and a leading transplant center of the Southwest. The area also has the largest single-site baby delivery facility in the nation. In 2007, over 16,000 babies were born at Parkland Memorial Hospital, almost 44 per day. (*Parkland Hospital*)
- ▶ UT Southwestern Medical Center's Southwestern Center for Minimally Invasive Surgery is one of seven facilities across the United States and Canada, and the only one in Texas, to garner first-time accreditation from the American College of Surgeons for its \$2 million training lab. (*UT Southwestern Medical Center*)
