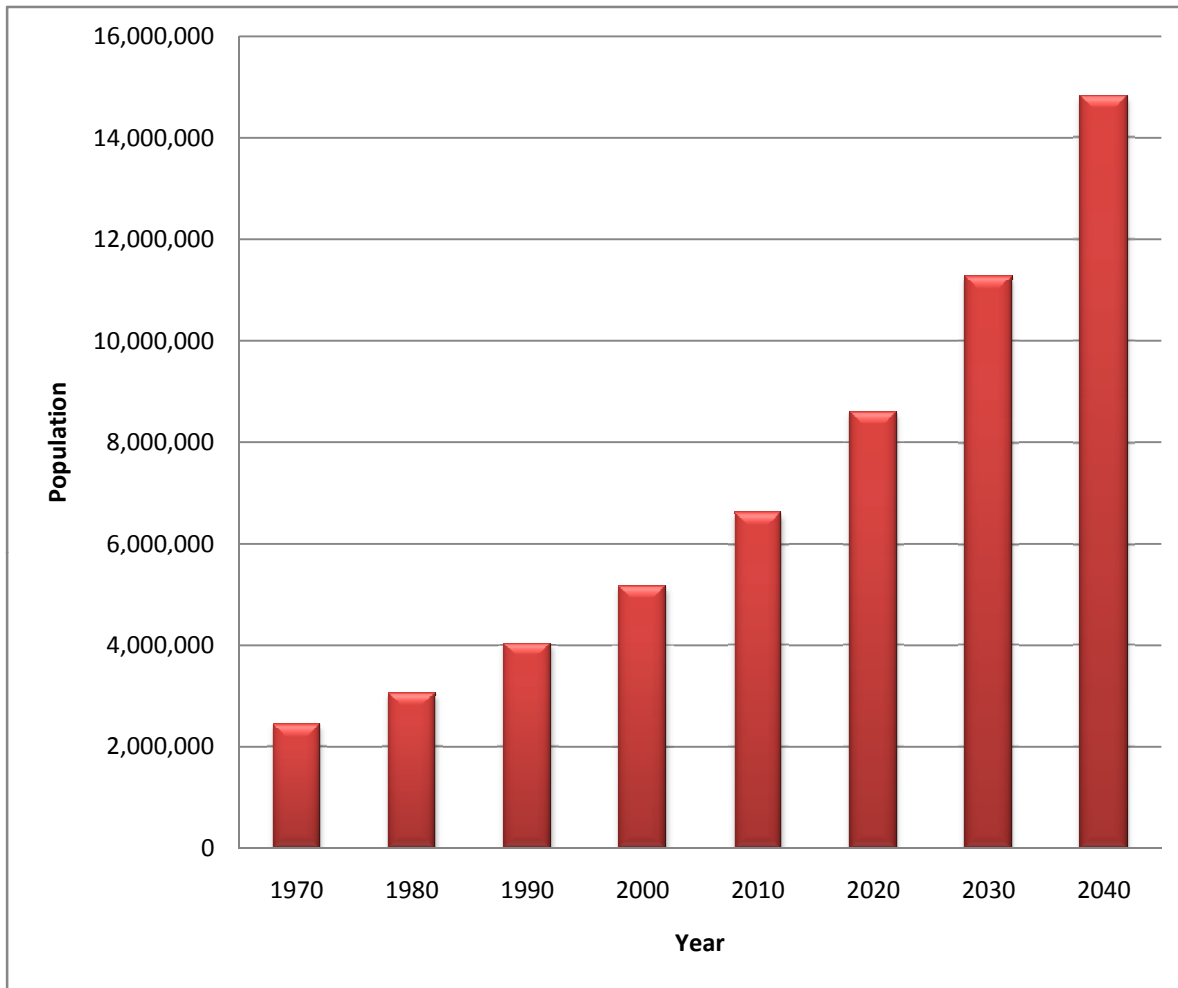

## Dallas-Fort Worth Population Projections



- ▶ If the Dallas-Fort Worth region were a state it would rank 17th in population, its 6.1 million residents would place it ahead of Tennessee and Missouri.
- ▶ The twelve county region is the nation's fourth most populous metro area. It has a population exceeding that of North and South Dakota, Alaska, Delaware, Vermont, Wyoming, and the District of Columbia combined.
- ▶ From 2006-2007 the region added over 400 new residents and 250 jobs per day.
- ▶ The Dallas-Fort Worth regions high quality of life and low cost of living serve a catalysts to continued growth and prospertiy.
