

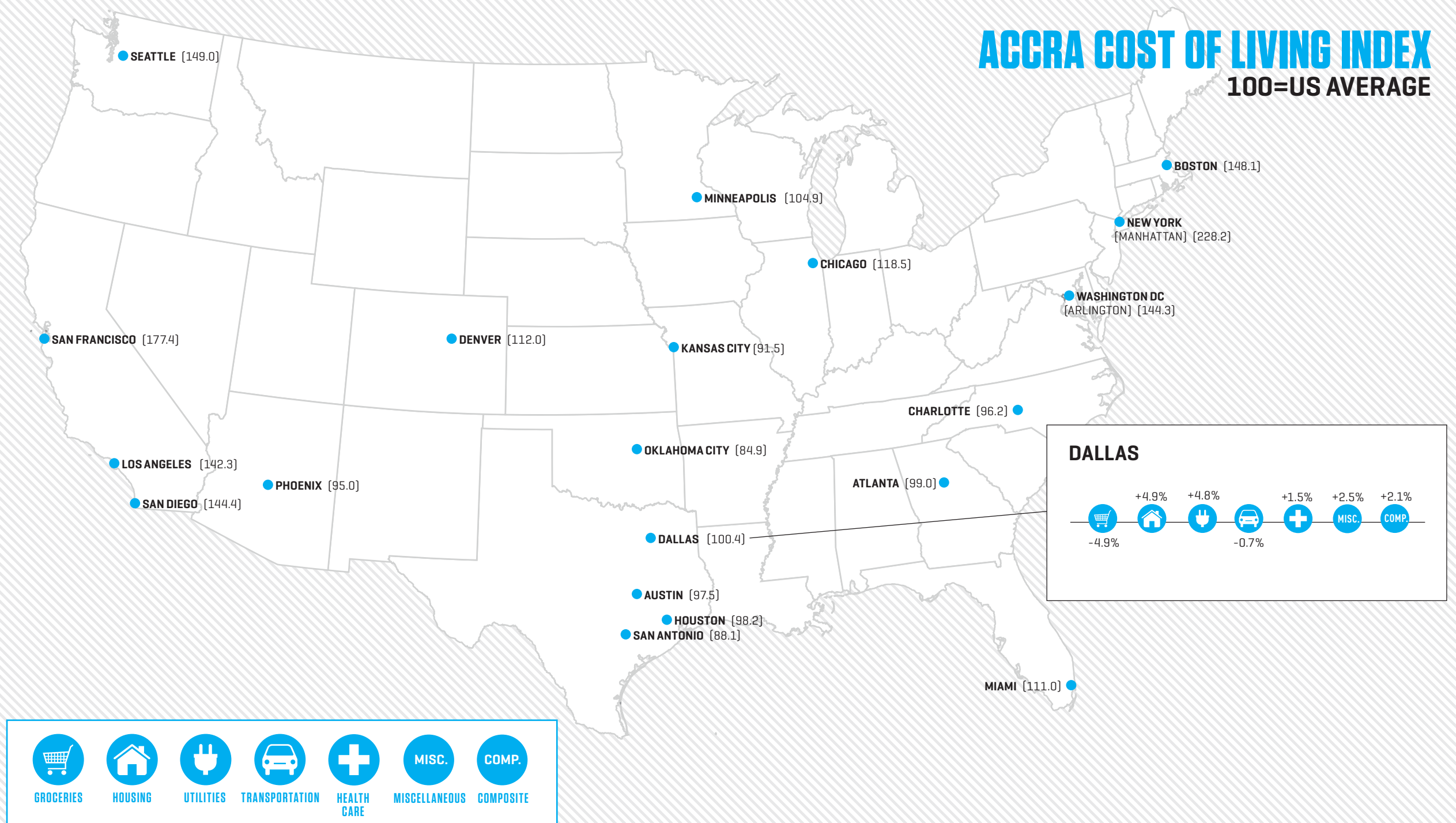
COST OF LIVING

The Dallas-Fort Worth region is one of the most affordable in the country. The low cost of living is a competitive advantage for companies as they seek to keep labor costs low and recruit the best workers.

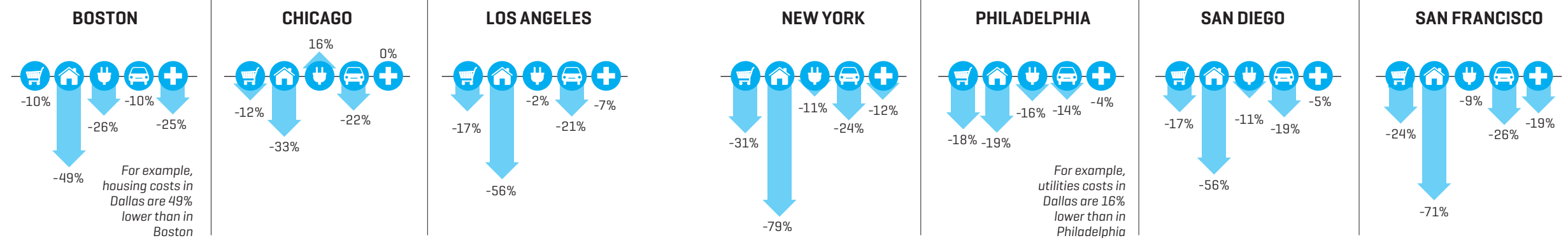
Employees in DFW enjoy a higher standard of living with lower housing costs as well as lower costs for housing, groceries, transportation, and health care. The region's relatively low housing prices — 24 percent lower than the national average and more than 50 percent lower than many other major metropolitan areas — provide a strong edge for companies that operate here.
