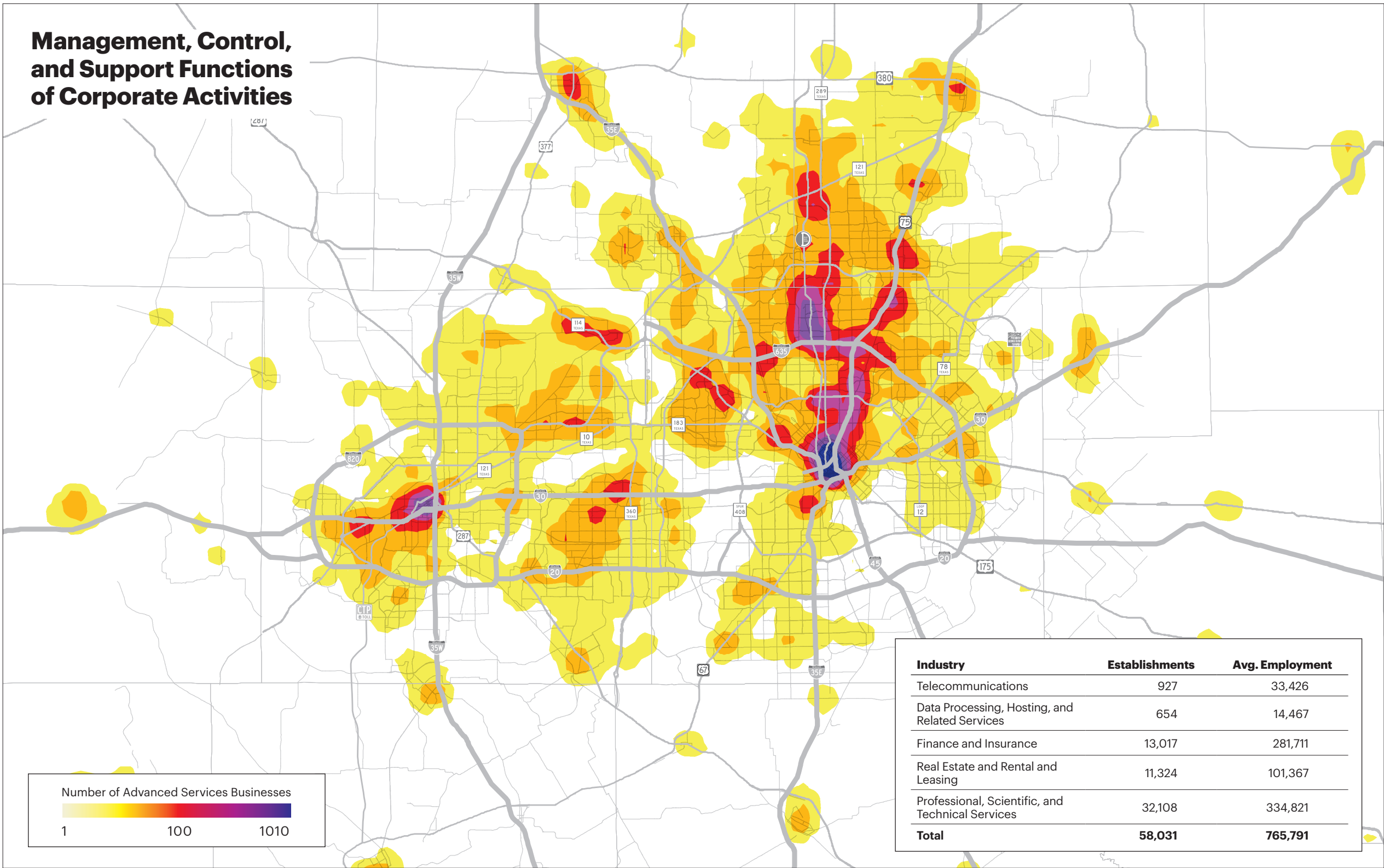


Advanced Services
