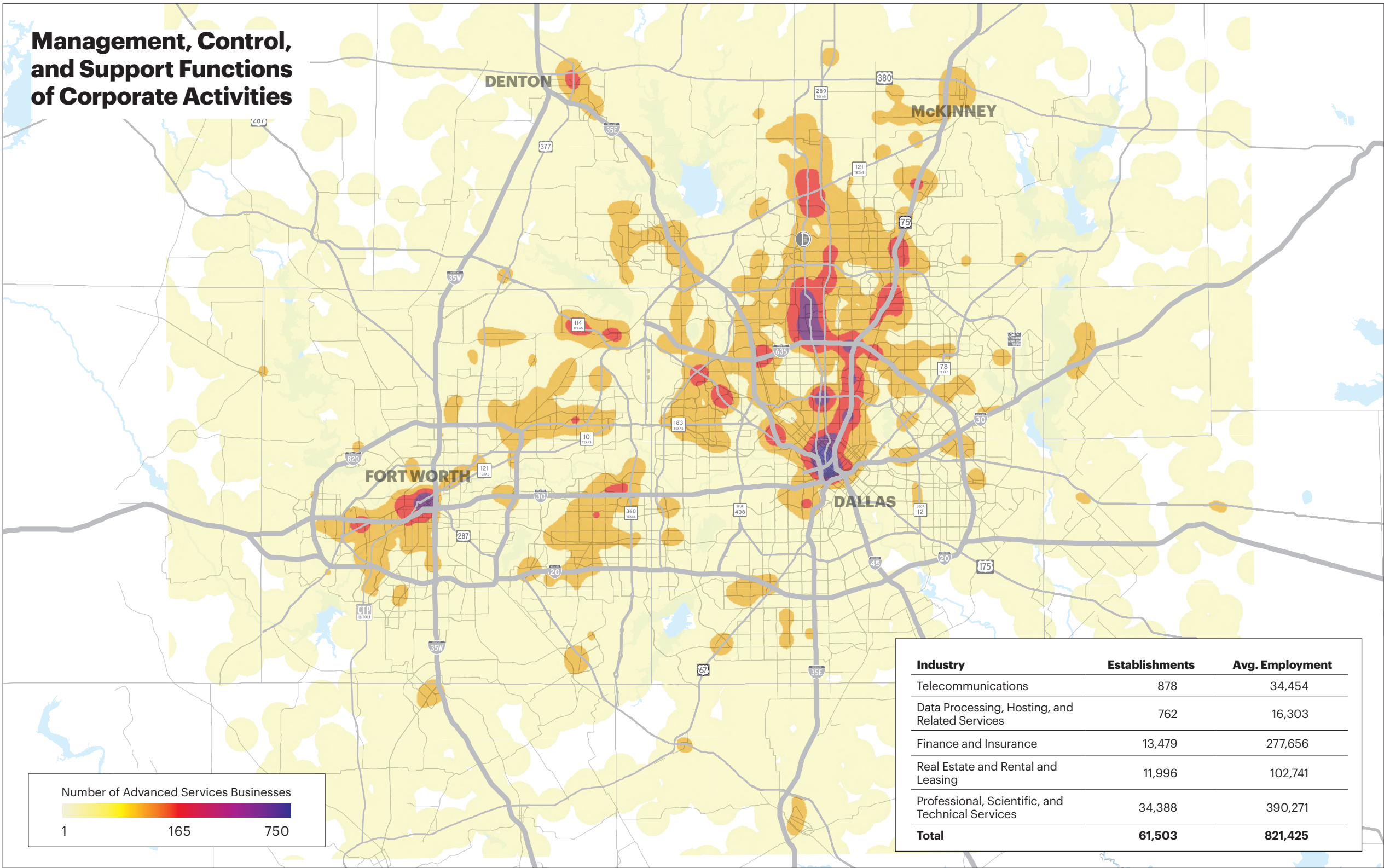


# Advanced Services
