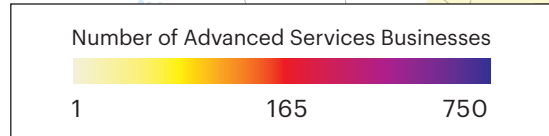
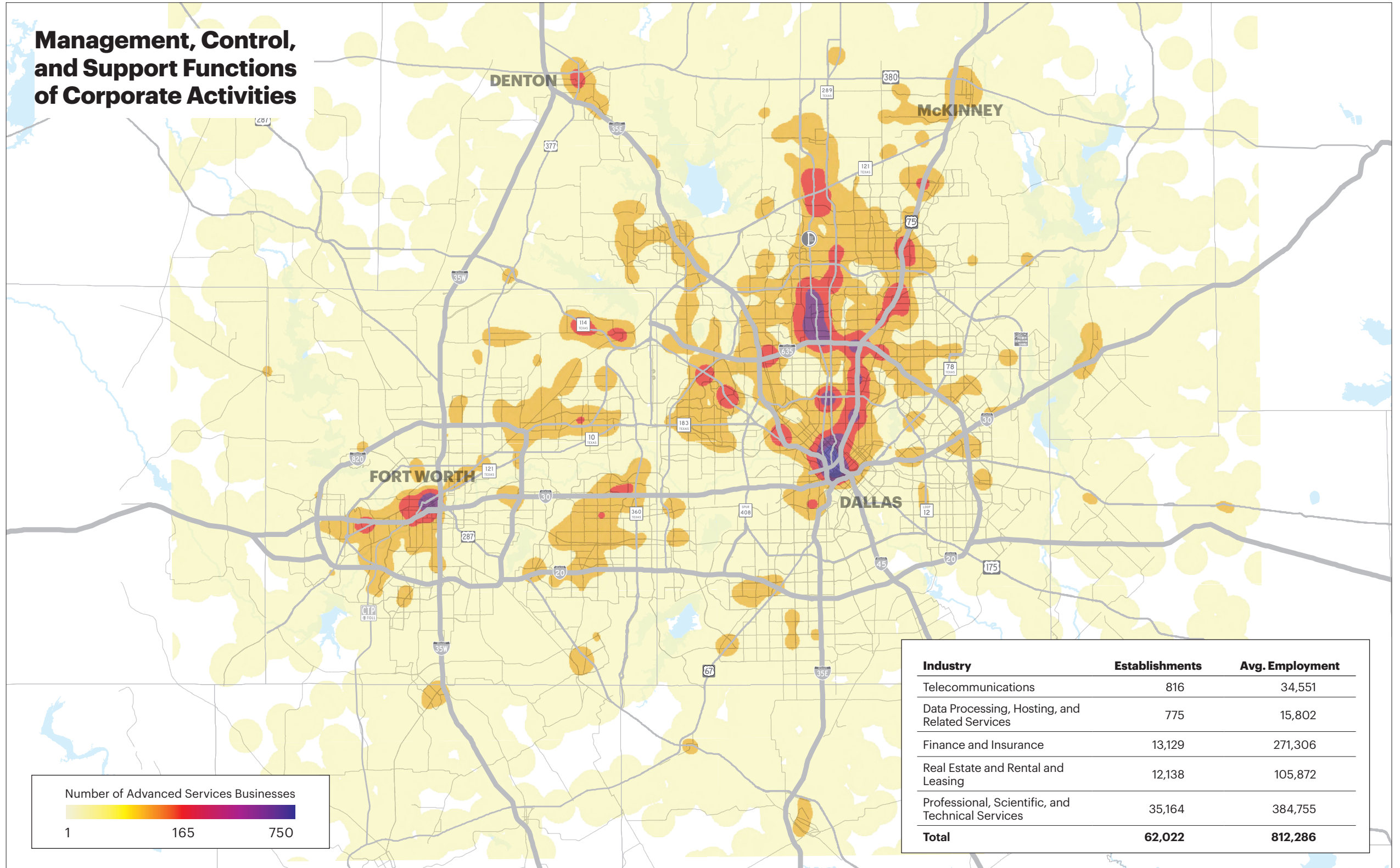


Advanced Services
